SUBSTANCE USE – RULES, REGULATIONS & PENALTIES

Participation in the Athletic Program at New Milford High School is intended to provide an opportunity for students to have challenging and meaningful experiences beyond the other available academic and activities programs.

Eligibility to participate in the interscholastic athletic program at New Milford High School is an earned privilege. Students seeking to become members of an athletic team(s) must meet all NJSIAA requirements (i.e., number of credits, age, etc.) and all New Milford Board of Education rules and regulations.

The New Milford High School Student Handbook provides information about the New Jersey Law and the New Milford Board of Education Policy on Substance Abuse (pp. 9 & 10). Student-Athletes are held responsible for knowing and following those rules and regulations

The use or possession of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, drug paraphernalia, narcotics and tobacco in any form is <u>UNACCEPTABLE</u> for any member of any athletic team during the season <u>either on or off the school premises</u>.

If it is reported and determined that a student-athlete has violated the "non-use" rules, the following penalties may be imposed and will be cumulative beginning with participants in the ninth grade.

Mandatory Counseling

Extra-curricular ineligibility for ten (10) days

of scheduled activities

Mandatory three (3) day out-of-school suspension

Police notification

SECOND OFFENSE: Parent Conference

Mandatory Counseling

Extra-curricular ineligibility - one (1) calendar year Mandatory ten (10) day out-of-school suspension

Police notification

RECOMMENDATION FOR EXPULSION

THIRD OFFENSE: Police notification

Exclusion from school pending Board hearing

for expulsion
